## The OmniPod DASH

Basic Information:

- The Omnipod is a small, tubeless, wearable, waterproof device. It holds up to 200units (2mL) of insulin and sticks directly onto the body (unlike the other two insulin pumps that use tubing).
- This Pod communicates wirelessly with the "Personal Diabetes Manager" (PDM) device that looks like a cell phone. This device is what contains all the pumps information & allows a person to adjust settings.
- The Pod gets replaced every 3 days with a new one, the PDM has a rechargeable battery.
